Week 5 - Reading Builds Confidence

*Each successful reading experience helps children believe in themselves as readers.
At home: Praise effort and improvement rather than speed or level.*

Recommended read: Amazing Grace by Mary Hoffman — a story about perseverance and believing in yourself



Week 6 - Rereading Strengthens Understanding

*Children often revisit favourite books to deepen comprehension and fluency.
At home: Encourage your child to reread a favourite story and notice new details.*

Recommended read: Brown Bear, Brown Bear, What Do You See? by Bill Martin Jr. & Eric Carle - repetitive text builds familiarity and confidence
