Week 9 - Reading Grows Vocabulary



Books introduce new words in meaningful contexts.
 At home: Choose one new word from a story to talk about or act out.
 Recommended read: *Marv and the Mega Robot* – fun adventure with vivid imagery.



Week 10 - Non-Fiction Builds Curiosity



Information texts teach children how to learn from reading.
 At home: Ask your child to share one fact they learned.
 Recommended read: *The World's Most Pointless Animals* – silly facts with great appeal.

ACCELERATED READER

As our KS2 parents know, all children in Y3-Y6 follow our Accelerated Reader reading programme, where they complete quizzes on the iPads/Chrome books after reading a book and Accelerated Reader then directs them to the correct level of book to read next - ensuring it is not too hard or too easy! The programme also counts up all words read by individual children and classes. Since coming back to school after the Autumn term our children in Y3-Y6 have read an amazing total of:
