Baby and toddler screen time guidance - Best Start in Life

This is a link to a new government website, giving lots of advice and guidance on screen time for under 5's.

- **Key takeaways:** Under 2 years-children should not be looking at phones/Ipads etc by themselves at all.
- 2-5 years - any use of screens should be limited to one hour or less.

Why is this important?

90% of brain growth happens before the age of 5. A large amount of screen time has negative effects on children's development. It can affect social, emotional and language development, sleep, eyesight and healthy weight.

There is also advice on the type of content best suited to young children along with 'safe swaps' you can use instead.



September 2026 School Transport Applications

Could you please remind all your school leavers that they need to complete a new application if they require transport assistance to their new school in September.

This will be assessed under Worcestershire County Council's Home to School Transport Policy and applications should be made via the Council's website: www.worcestershire.gov.uk/SchoolTransportApplication. It is important that an application is made online as soon as possible, or at least before 30th June, to ensure that the request can be assessed and any pass issued in time for the start of the new academic year. Late applications (submitted after 30th June) will still be accepted but MAY NOT be assessed in time for the start of the new academic year. **IF A TRANSPORT APPLICATION HAS ALREADY BEEN SUBMITTED FOR SEPTEMBER THERE IS NO NEED TO DO SO AGAIN AND WE WILL ADVISE YOU OF THE OUTCOME OVER THE COMING MONTHS.** Alternatively, you can view any progress via the Application Tracker (www.worcestershire.gov.uk/ApplicationTracker), using the EDT Reference Number provided when you submitted the application.
