ONLINE SAFETY NEWSLETTER

The focus for our May Online Safety newsletter is 'GroupChats'. Is your child part of any group chats? This could be on social media, for example WhatsApp or within games such as Fortnite. If so, there is lots of advice on the newsletter about potential risks, which include :

- Inappropriate Content
- Bullying
- Strangers (your child could be added to groups with people they don't know)
- Conversations can be shared/screenshot
- Sharing personal information

There is also information on a concerning new website called 'Freezenova', and also an update on Roblox, but as a lot of content is user generated, not all games will be suitable for your child to view. It is important to monitor what your child is accessing and who they are talking to, as well as setting up appropriate parental controls.
